Key Features





2nd largest jute producer; annual production about 9 million bales of jute, which is about 70% of global production

Average production of jute goods is **1.6** million MT; Average internal consumption **1.4** million MT

220 private mills under Bangladesh Jute Spinners Association and Bangladesh Jute Mills Association

Top exporter of jute and jute-based products in the world



Bangladesh **exports 42**% jute products worldwide

Economic Overview



An average contribution of **3%** in export earnings and **1%** in GDP



Bangladesh holds around **72**% of the global export earning of jute

Average exports around **US\$ 1 billion** per annum



Expected to export jute goods worth **US\$5 billion** within the next five years



Export Earning Status of FY 2022-23

Jute and jute made goods export in FY 2022-2023 is **US\$ 912.25 million**

Jute goods export in FY 2022-23 is **US\$ 708.08 million** and raw iute is **US\$ 204.17 million**

Jute yarn & twine remains the dominant export item (US\$ 497.94 million in FY 2022-23)



Other jute products rose by almost **8%** to **US\$100.30 million** in FY 2023, compared to the previous year

Jute sacks and bags accounted for **US\$ 109.84 million**

Sacks/ hessian export has been growing at an annual rate of over **15%** since July 2016

Favourble Jute Production





Country's strategic geographic location, potential economic corridors, and the Bay of Bengal offers easy trading access to the Asia-Pacific region and Middle Eastern's big consumer markets.

32 countries — including members of the European Union — have already banned the use of plastic bags.

Preferential overseas market access to **52 countries**.



Skilled and Competitive Labour Force

The minimum monthly wage is **US\$ 45.32**. Private Jute Industries pay **US\$ 74.76** per month to their workers.

Production of **8.27 million** bales in FY 2021-2022.



Worldwide Demand of Jute Bags

The annual demand for jute shopping bags stands at around **500 billion** pieces globally.



Low Production Costs

Jute goods production cost in Bangladesh is one of the lowest in the world. The current production cost of each 10-gram bag is **US\$.065**



Demand for Home Décor The market for jute-made home décor/ furnishing products has been on the rise worldwide, especially in the

EU countries.



Middle and affluent class MAC consumers-34 million by 2025.



Demand for Diversified Products

Global demand for diversified products such as shopping/ sacking bags, geotextile, floor covers to grow rapidly.



Biodegradable Jute-tin Jute-tin is a result of R&D by Bangladeshi scientists and is deemed as more durable (withstanding rust and saline) and stronger than

metallic-tin.



Jute Technical and Geo Textiles

Global demand for technical textile projected to grow at a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of **4.5**% between the period 2018 and 2025, and reach **US\$ 335 billion** by 2025.



Global Market Insights expects jute-based geotextile market to grow at a CAGR of **9.5%** and exceed **US\$ 200 million** by 2024.

Potential Jute Sticks

Demand for high-quality charcoal is huge in China where charcoal is used among many industries.
Bangladesh produces around **3 million** jute sticks annually. The country has the potential to export jute stick based charcoal worth **US\$ 3.0 to 3.5 billion**.

Hot Spots for Foreign Investment



Packaging Material- Jute bags and other forms of packaging as biodegradable materials.

Home Décor/ Furnishing- Jute-based home décor/ furnishing goods such as rug, mat, outdoor furniture, sofa cover, cushion, lamp shade.





Jute Technical (Agrotech, Buildtech, Clothtech) and Geo Textiles- Canvas cloth and tarpaulins, jute laminates, jute and jute blended fabrics, soil savers.

Automotive Textiles- Jute application in automobiles has been expanding. Nearly two thirds of the automobile textiles are for interior trim, i.e., seat cover, carpets and roof and door liners. Global brands such as BMW, Mercedes, Volvo, Audi, Daimler Chrysler and Ford have been using jute-based composites for door panels and dashboards.





Jute Stick Charcoal Products - Foreign investors are welcome to invest for commercial production of jute stick charcoal products, such as cosmetics, medicines, battery, photocopier (dried ink), water purification filter, etc.

Biodegradable Jute-tin Foreign investors are welcome to invest for commercialization and mechanization of biodegradable jute-tin.



Enabling Policies and Incentives

Incentives Related to Diversified Jute Products

Reduced income tax rate of 10 percent for companies engaged in jute production. (SRO-104-AIN/Income Tax/2020)

Export Subsidies

50% tax exemption for income derived from export.

No VAT imposition on export goods.

20% cash incentive on export of diversified jute product.

20% cash incentive on export value of jute stick carbon.

12% cash incentive on export of jute made final goods (hessian, jute sack, etc.).

7% cash incentive on exporting jute fibers (yarn and twine).


